# 2006 (11U) Spring Events

This Spring, 2006 birth-year teams will be competing in one of three statewide tournaments:



**Illinois State Cup:** Open to any Illinois Youth Soccer member team but designed for the top/most competitive teams in an age group. 13U and older state champions advance to a Regional event



**Illinois Presidents Cup:** Open to any Illinois Youth Soccer member team but designed for very competitive teams. Presidents Cup is the Europa League to the State Cup's Champions League. 13U and older state champions advance to a Regional event



**Illinois Cup:** New state championship tournament for teams that play in the 3<sup>rd</sup> tier of league play or below.

All 2006 (11U) Cup matches are scheduled for May 6-7 in Naperville at the Polo Fields. Teams can move a game to a location other than Naperville, slide 6 will provide details on that process.

Teams that advance out of group play, will move on to Illinois Youth Soccer Spring Championship Weekend, June 3-4 in Rockford.

Some teams have a home team host match that needs to be played by May 3.

- May 3: Home Team Host Play By Date
- May 6-7: Group play games in Naperville
- June 2-4: Spring Championship Weekend (Rockford)

# Moving Games

**FOR GAMES SCHEDULED IN NAPERVILLE, GAMES CAN BE MOVED TO ANOTHER LOCATION AND DATE AS LONG AS**

1. The **TEAMS MUTUALLY AGREE** to the change
2. THE rescheduled match is played **NO LATER THAN THE DATE IT HAS BEEN SCHEDULED BY ILLINOIS YOUTH SOCCER**

# Referees

The Illinois Youth Soccer assignor assigns the ENTIRE REFEREE CREW for all matches.

**BOTH teams pay \$60 in cash each to the center prior to the match starting.**

# Rosters

Teams are allowed to use any age eligible player from within their club that is registered with an Illinois Youth Soccer competitive league for tournament play. Those leagues are: YSSL, IWSL, CIYSL, SISL or ILLOWA.

**GUEST PLAYERS FROM OTHER CLUBS ARE NOT ALLOWED.**

**Team playing in Illinois Cup can only roster players that compete in YSSL 3<sup>rd</sup> Division, IWSL B Division or CIYSL Gold or lower.**

**All players must have a US Youth Soccer/ IYSA Competitive league pass from and rostered thru one of the Illinois Youth Soccer member leagues listed above.**

**Team must email a copy of the member league roster showing ALL players listed on their official Cup roster to [chrisj@illinoisyouthsoccer.org](mailto:chrisj@illinoisyouthsoccer.org) NO LATER THAN WEDNESDAY, MAY 3**

# Rosters

**Once a team has played their first Group Play game, NO ROSTER CHANGES ARE ALLOWED FOR THE DURATION OF THE TOURNAMENT**

# GotSoccer Rosters

**All players that will compete in the tournament must be entered into GotSoccer in the official roster no later than May 3. The maximum number of players is 18 for 11U & 12U. Include every player even if a player may be missing the first game(s). Your roster FREEZES after your first match , NO ADDITIONS after the first game of the event. Only players who are listed on the official Cup roster are eligible to compete.**

To Enter Players Into Your Tournament Roster

1. Login to your team GotSoccer account
2. You will be taken to your team's Overview page. At the top of the page there is a Gray Bar that runs the length of the page "Overview" is highlighted in light blue. On that bar click on ROSTER. This will take you to your PRIMARY PLAYER LIST
3. Add all your players here (NOT AS GUEST PLAYERS). To add players click the REGISTER NEW PLAYER button and enter the player's info. The main information to enter is the player's name, birthdate and id number. If the system asks for any other info (phone, email, etc.) you can just enter the club's info
4. After you have entered all the players, from the VIEW BY EVENT dropdown menu select the 2006 (11U) Spring Statewide Tournaments: State Cup, Presidents Cup, Illinois Cup. All the players you entered should now be listed.
5. Once all players are entered click the GENERATE ROSTER button. This WILL FREEZE YOUR ROSTER. Do not freeze your roster until it is finalized.

# Gameday

**Teams are required to bring the following to all tournament Games:**

1. Player and Coaching Passes
2. **\$60 referee fee**
3. **Pinnies. See next slide**
4. **\$50 per game fee for matches played in Rockford.**

# Gameday - Pinnies

**Teams are required to have players sitting on the bench wear pinnies until they check in.**

**Referees will enforce this rule during the match.**

**Teams that fail to have pinnies for home team host games may be subject to a \$100 fine.**

**Teams that do not have pinnies for matches in Naperville or Rockford will be charged a \$10 per pinnie rental fee.**

# After Your Match

At the conclusion of the match the **winning team** (or home team if a draw in Group Play) should get the gamecard from the center referee.

1. For games played in Naperville or Rockford, at the conclusion of the match a team representative is required to bring the game card to the IYSA registration area to report the score
2. For matches held at a location other than Naperville or Rockford, the winning team is required to scan or take a photo of BOTH gamecards and email them to [chrisj@illinoisyouthsoccer.org](mailto:chrisj@illinoisyouthsoccer.org) **no later than 48 hours after the conclusion of the match.**

**Teams that fail to report their result in a timely manor may be subject to a \$50 fine**

If a **red card** is issued during the match, the center will keep the gamecard to submit with the red card report. **Any player or coach that is issued a red card (or 2 yellows) is REQUIRED TO SIT THE NEXT MATCH or longer, WHETHER OR NOT THE PLAYER IS CROSSED OFF ON THE GOTSOCCKER GAMECARD. Teams that use a player that should be serving a red card suspension will FORFEIT THE MATCH.**

Red Card Fines:

- Players: \$50. Must be paid prior to the player being eligible to return to Cup games
- Coach: \$250. Must be paid prior to coach be eligible to return to sidelines for a Cup game.

Any outstanding red card fines not paid at the conclusion of the tournament will be billed to the club.

## Illinois Cup Rules

Rules of note:

1. Unlimited substitutions
2. 11U – NO HEADING

## Group Play Scoring

Group play will be based on the same scoring used at the US Youth Soccer Midwest Regionals:

Win: 3 points

Tie: 1 points

Loss: 0 points

If group play ends in a tie, the following criteria will determine tie-breakers.

1st: Head-to-head

2nd: Most Wins

3rd: Goal Differential (4 goal max per game)

4th: Goals Allowed

5th: Penalty Kicks
