## **ELIGIBLE TEAMS**

In order to be eligible for the 12U Illinois MWC Qualifier your team and ALL PLAYERS MUST be registered to one of the following Illinois Youth Soccer member competitive leagues for the 2023/2024 season.









## **SCHEDULING GAMES**

- Schedules posted online
- All games are self-schedule
- Teams listed as home should host, unless otherwise agreed
- All Games must be completed by June 18
- Teams that do not complete games will be fined per game and may not be accepted into Fall

# **SCHEDULING GAMES**

- Teams contact each other and agree to game details
  - Team contact email found on each team's 12U Illinois MWC Qualifier home page
- Hosting team submits the following information to <u>iysascheduling@gmail.com</u>
  - Subject of emails should read 12U ILLINOIS MWC MATCH
  - Body of email should include:
    - Gender
    - Teams Playing or Game Number
    - Date of Match
    - Time of Match
    - Location Be Specific Include Address & Field Number

#### DO NOT INCLUDE IYSA STAFF ON GAME NEGOTIATIONS. ONLY SEND US FINALIZED GAME INFO.





## **GAME CHANGES**

- Teams are allowed unlimited game changes
- For the time being THIS PROCESS MAY CHANGE To change a previously scheduled match, an email must be sent to <u>iysascheduling@gmail.com</u> with reps from BOTH teams included on the email
  - Subject of emails should read 12U ILLINOIS MWC QUALIFIER MATCH CHANGE
  - Body of email should include:
    - Game Number Of Match
    - New Date of Match
    - New Time of Match
    - New Location Be Specific Include Address & Field Number
- Games canceled without notifying IYSA may be subject to fines or forfeits

## FINAL TEAM RANKINGS

Illinois is guaranteed 8 spots in the Fall 2024 13U Midwest Conference Premier Division.

Those spots and any spots beyond that will be filled based on the final results of this competition.





### REFEREES

- The IYSA State Assignor send all 3 referees for each match UNLESS TEAMS REQUEST TO USE A LOCAL ASSIGNOR BY AUGUST 22
- BOTH teams pay \$80 AT the field for each match
- We are using a new ref assignor and his contact info will be available on the website in the near future for any day of referee issues





## Rosters

- Roster must be entered in GotSport
- Teams are allowed to use any age eligible player from within their club.
- Only players that are registered in a member competitive league & have a USYS/IYSA member league pass are allowed to compete
- No guest players from outside the club
- Can use up to 30 players PER season
- 18 players dress on gameday
- Player can play on only 1 Illinois MWC Qualifier Teams at a time. If a play does a proper transfer they can play with their new team. Teams can only have up to 5 previously registered players
- If have other teams in IYSA member competitive league play make sure you know their rules about player movement





# MATCH DAY – WHAT TO BRING

Each team is required to bring each of the following for EVERY match

- \$80 cash payment for referees
- Match card printed off GotSport up to 18 players can dress on match day. Any players

no competing should be crossed off the match card before giving to the referee

• Player & Coaches pass from an IYSA member competitive league. Mobile passes are ok





## **REPORTING RESULTS**

The WINNING team or the HOME TEAM IF A DRAW, collects BOTH match cards from the referee at the conclusion of the match and does one of the following to report the score:

- Scan or take a photo of BOTH match cards and email them to iysascoring@gmail.com
- Follow the prompts on the match card to enter score online or via phone
- Results should be submitted no later than 24-hours after the conclusion of the match

#### IF THERE IS A RED CARD THE REFEREE WILL KEEP THE MATCH CARDS TO SEND IN THE RED CARD REPORT

## **PLAYING RULES**

Complete playing rules can be found on the 12U Illinois MWC Qualifier page of the IYSA website. Few rules of note:

- Match lengths = Cup match lengths. This may be different than league play
- NO HARD CASTS
- Unlimited subs for all age groups
- Red Cards = fines & suspensions for players (\$50), coaches (\$300) & spectators (\$300)
  - It is the responsibility of the coach to control their spectators section.
  - Outstanding fines are the responsibility of the club to get paid
  - Players & coaches MUST sit at least the next Premiership match
  - Games were red card coach or player participates will result in forfeits & fines
  - Team may keep the player or coach passes

## FALL 2024 13U MIDWEST CONFERENCE PLAY

- The Fall 2024 13U Midwest Conference will serve as a qualifying season for Premier I positions
- Division are broken up geographically into color divisions
  - Example 13U Boys Premier White, 13U Boys Premier Blue
- Placement into these Premier "Color" Division earned thru the 12U Illinois MWC Qualifiers
- Final placement determined by Midwest Conference seeding committee
- Teams that do not get placed into Premier "Color" Division can play in the 13U Qualifying Division.
