

Illinois Youth Soccer Game Officials Fees – Rules and Regulations

IL State Premiership (SPD) & Midwest Conference Qualifiers (MWC Q)

All teams are to use their own local assignor.

- o IYSA will be responsible for paying the assignor.
- o IYSA sets referee assignor fees at \$18/game assigning three referees.
- Assignors can charge for late changes or late cancellations however, this will be between clubs and assignors. IYSA will only be responsible for the initial assigning fee \$18/game
- o Both MWC Qualifiers and IL State Premiership are self-schedule. Teams will provide assignor with schedule and any game changes. The schedules can also be found here:
 - o 12U Illinois MWC Qualifiers
 - o 13U-17U Illinois MWC Qualfiiers
 - State Premiership

Amount of games expected to initially assign (not including game changes)

- 13U-17U MWC Qualifiers and IL Premiership will have between 4-6 home games to assign.
- 12U MWC Qualifiers will have between 10-12 games from Fall 2024 Spring 2024, meaning the 10-12 games can be split between the seasons depending on how teams schedule.

Referee Pay

This will be shared with clubs, please share with referees on what to expect.

BOTH teams pay the following prior to the kick-off of a State Premiership or MWC Q match if there is a three-man system. Assume there will always be three officials and always bring the following:

- 12U/14U: \$80 per game (Each team brings: 2 \$20 bills, 4 \$10 bills)
 Referee Pay \$60 -\$50-\$50
 15U/16U: \$85 per game (Each team brings: 2 \$20 bills, 4 \$10 bills, 1 \$5 bill)
 Referee Pay \$ \$70-\$50-\$50
- 17U-19U: \$95 per game (Each team brings: 4 \$20 bills, 1 \$10 bills, 1 \$5 bill)
 - Referee Pay \$80 \$55-\$55

BOTH teams pay the following prior to the kick-off of an SPD or MWC Q match if there is a two-man system(Referees would split evenly):

- 12U/14U: \$60 per team (Each team will pay: 2 \$20 bills, 2 \$10 bills)
 15U/16U: \$70 per team (Each team brings: 2 \$20 bills, 3 \$10 bills)
- o 17U-19U: \$80 per team (Each team brings: 4 \$20 bills)
- No exceptions, both teams must pay the referee at field regardless of the game situation.
- If a game is cut short due to weather or an unforeseen circumstance beyond both teams' control, referees will be paid the full amount.
- If a game does not start due to weather or an unforeseen circumstance beyond both team's control, referees will all get paid \$50.00 - \$75 a team.
- If a game is cut short or does not start and a team is responsible, for example, lack of players or improper field conditions, referees will get paid the full amount and both teams will be responsible for payment at the field. In said circumstances, the team not responsible for the issue will be reimbursed upon match completion. A report from the club must be sent to vince@illinoisyouthsoccer.org

- o Match Day:
 - All players must have an ID from an IYSA member league
 - **IWSL**
 - LDE
 - YSSL
 - CIYSL
 - SLYSA
 - o All adults on the bench must show an IYSA member competitive league issued coaches
 - Cash Payment listed previously
 - Printed match card
 - Winning team should get match card to send to IYSA
 - If draw, home team should get match card to send to IYSA
 - If Red Card is given, please have referee send in match card and report into iysascoring@gmail.com
