## LEAGUE GAME CHANGES

Participation in Junior Cup does NOT exempt you from fees charged by leagues for game changes, even if you advance to the elimination rounds

The YSSL free game change deadline is August 14 The IWSL free game change deadline is August 16

All teams should move any game scheduled on October 18 (Girls) - 19 (Boys) to a different date should they advance to elimination rounds.

Should your team not advance - you have now created a built-in rain date for the Fall.









## **MOVING GAMES**

Teams can mutually agree to move a game schedule in Rockford on October 4-5 to another date and location

## • BOTH teams MUST be in agreement

- Game changes must be submitted by 6pm on Saturday, August 16.
- Games must be played by September 21
- IYSA will still send the referees for moved games
- IYSA does NOT pay any field rental fees for moved games
- Semis & Finals are to be played in Rockford UNLESS SPECIFICALLY APPROVED BY IYSA





## **MOVING GAMES**

Teams contact each other and come to an agreement on moving a Junior Cup game.

Once an agreement is made, the team HOSTING the match must complete the online Home Team Host / Cup Game Change Form.

If a match is moved to a location other than Rockford and is cancelled due to weather:

- If prior to kick off Notify the assignor.
- If the game is stopped during or pre-game, teams should work to finalize a reschedule.
- There is NO defined time that constitues a completed match. That is at the discretion of the Cup Director.
- IYSA will not delay elimination rounds due me to moved games not being completed due to weather.





The IYSA State Assignor, Patrick Legge, sends referees for all Junior Cup matches including games moved to alternative locations.

You DO NOT need to confirm any referees with Patrick once the game change form is submitted.











All roster must be entered in the official Junior Cup roster in GotSport. There is a walk thru video on how to do so if you have never used GotSport before

Teams are ONLY allowed to use age eligible players currently registered to their club.

#### NO GUEST PLAYERS FROM OUTSIDE THE CLUB.

#### A player can only be on 1 Junior Cup roster.

Maximum roster size is 18 players.

Upon request, a team MUST be able to show an IYSA league roster showing all players registered to your club







ONCE YOU PLAY YOUR FIRST GAME YOUR ROSTER IS FROZEN FOR THE DURATION OF THE TOURNAMENT



JUNIOR ILLINOIS CUP: ONLY players roster to C/3rd Division in league play can be on a Junior Illinois Cup roster.

ROSTER DEADLINE: NO LATER THAN
SEPTEMBER 8 or 48 hours prior to your first
match, whichever comes first, initial roster
must be entered in GotSport.

- For teams playing their first games in Rockford on October 4-5 you can make adjustments until 10am on October 1.
- For teams NOT playing Rockford, you can make changes to your roster up to 48-hours prior to your first game.

## WHAT TO BRING ON GAME DAY

For EVERY game teams need to bring the following

- IYSA member competitive league issued player pass for all players competing
  - MOBILE VERSIONS OK
  - Printed OK
- IYSA member competitive league issued coaches pass for ALL adults on the sidelines during a game.
- For games NOT played in Rockford teams also must print and bring their match card to each game







REPORTING SCORES The WINNING team or the HOME TEAM IF A DRAW, collects BOTH match cards from the referee at the conclusion of the match and does one of the following to report the score:

#### FOR GAMES IN ROCKFORD

Bring match cards to IYSA staff on site

IF THERE IS A RED CARD THE REFEREE
WILL KEEP THE MATCH CARDS TO SEND
IN THE RED CARD REPORT

#### **FOR GAMES NOT ROCKFORD**

- •Scan or take a photo of BOTH match cards and email them to <a href="mailto:iysascoring@gmail.com">iysascoring@gmail.com</a>
- •Results should be submitted no later than 24-hours after the conclusion of the match



Complete playing rules will be posted on the Junior Cup page by 8/12.

#### Few rules of note:

- Match lengths may be different than league play
- •NO HARD CASTS
- Unlimited subs for all age groups
- •**Red Cards** = fines & suspensions for players (\$50), coaches (\$300) & spectators (\$300)
- •It is the responsibility of the coach to control their spectators section.
- Outstanding fines are the responsibility of the club to get paid
- •Players & coaches MUST sit at least the next match
- •Games where red card coach or player participates will result in forfeits & fines
- Team may keep the player or coach passes







# SCORING & TIEBREAKERS

#### **GROUP PLAY SCORING**

Win: 3 points

Tie: 1 points

Loss: 0 points

#### **GROUP PLAY TIEBREAKERS**

If group play ends in a tie, the following

criteria will determine tie-breakers.

1st: Head-to-head

2nd: Most Wins

3rd: Goal Differential (5 goal max per game)

4th: Goals Allowed

5th: Least Red Card Received

6th: Goals For

7th: Most Shutouts

8th: Penalty Kicks
